

Broomhaugh & Riding Parish Council Members' Allowances Policy

Broomhaugh & Riding Parish Council does not pay allowances to councillors for any purpose. However, all councillors are entitled to reimbursement of reasonable travel and other actual expenses incurred in the course of their official duties. These can be claimed by completing the appropriate form, available from the Parish Clerk. The mileage rate payable is in line with Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs (HMRC) advice, details of which are available on the Northumberland County Council website. Any councillor claiming reimbursement expenses is prohibited from authorising their own online payment/cheque.
