Who will be doing the works?

The contractors for the main works will be Northumberland County Council.

How long will the work take?

These works will take place under a road closure are estimated to take up to FIVE DAYS,
weather permitting.

Will the works be disruptive? The kerbing works, signage & Road Markings will take place between the hours of 7:00am to 17:00pm, Monday to Friday (though signs will be erected beforehand with specific times) under a road closure thus allowing works to be carried out as quickly and as safely as possible. The road closure may need to be kept on overnight to allow the rumble strips to adhere to the carriageway surface

Advance notice boards will be erected giving further information, near to the time of the works.
